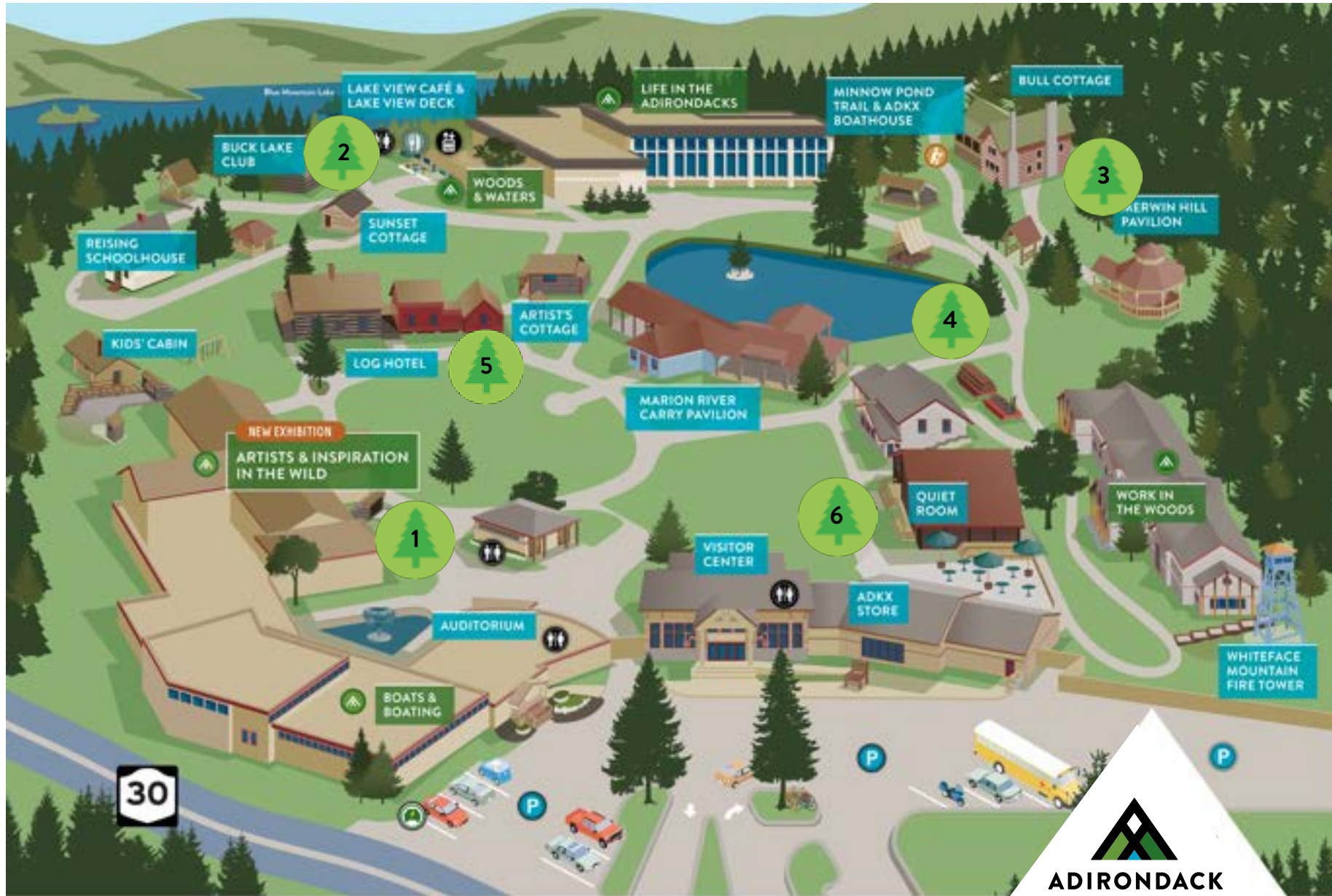


TREE ID SCAVENGER HUNT

WHITE BIRCH



Take a closer look:
There are teeth on the leaf edge, like a saw.



RED SPRUCE



Take a closer look:
The needles are sharp when you squeeze them.



MOUNTAIN ASH



Take a closer look:
The leaf has many leaflets attached to a middle vein, like a feather.



WHITE PINE



Take a closer look:
Needles are in bunches of 5.



SUGAR MAPLE



Take a closer look:
Leaves are lobed.



BALSAM FIR



Take a closer look:
The needles smell nice when you rub them
